1. The article should be of minimum 1000 words and maximum 3000 words.
2. The article should be relevant to Information Technology / Information Systems and/or Information System's Audit.
3. Contributors are encouraged to include exhibits, graphics and artwork for an article. These will assist the reader in comprehending and retaining the information in your article.
4. Electronic submission in Microsoft Word is required
5. These documents parameters must be followed:
  - Track changes to be put off and all changes to be accepted/rejected, as appropriate.
  - All comments to be removed
  - Standard printer specs to be selected
  - Special characters or keys to be avoided (for example, for indents use the TAB rather than the indent key).
  - Endnotes at the end of the article, rather than footnotes, to be used to credit sources.
  - Material to be submitted in English.
6. All relevant source information (e.g., author, publisher, title of book or article, magazine name, date/year of publication, country of publication)
7. A reference section should be included for all general reference(s).
8. Citations or copyright acknowledgements are needed for any materials that are not solely the original creation of the contributor.
9. Manuscripts are subject to review by the Editorial Board/Committee.

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
